Paul Huang is Head of the Molecular and Systems Oncology Laboratory at The Institute of Cancer Research (ICR) in London, UK. His laboratory focuses on understanding aberrant signaling networks and drug resistance in sarcomas, with the goal of developing biomarkers and new therapies for these rare diseases.
